Caumont L'Envente, France, 13 June 1944: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from ASL. Ownership of Advanced Tobruk, Darkest December and ASL boards 4, 53 & 54 are necessary for play. VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Americans win if at the end of any turn they control at least 12 multi level stone buildings, provided the Germans do not amass more than 40 US Casualty VPs. Rowhouses, building with black bars, count as 1 building only.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

1. Spotting conditions are Average. All hedges are Bocage.
2. All German AFVs are equipped with Schuerzen. All Flank armor factors are +2.
3. Up to 3 American squads plus any leaders and L/M weapons that set up with them may set up on board 53, all other American units must set up on board 54.
