VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Germans win at game end if there are no non broken/surrendered Russian squads on any Level +30 hex.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

1. Spotting conditions are average. Pre Dawn conditions exist on turns 1-3, apply a +1/1L modifier
2. The Germans receive 2 Stukas on Turn 4.
3. The Russian has an offboard FO at Level +30 on the east edge. He may access a 76mm OBA (He & Smoke).

BALANCE

- ★ Russian OBA has High ammunition.
