

ATS BV1 Fighting Withdrawal – ATS Conversion 12/03/2006



Sestroretsk Road, Terijoki, 2 September 1941: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Advanced Squad Leader (ASL). Ownership of Mannerheim's Cross is necessary for play as is ASL Board 21. Please refer to Beyond Valor 1 for the historical background to this scenario as well as its aftermath.

VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Finnish player must exit more Victory Points off the south board edge than the Russian player.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

- Spotting conditions are Average.
- Level +0 and +10 of U6 and G2 have flame markers.
- The Russian player may use Hidden setup for 2 squads plus any leader and L/M weapon that stacks with them and may place them anywhere on or south of row AA.

BALANCE

- ★ Add a 547 squad and a LMG to the Russian order of battle.
- 🦁 Increase game length to 8 turns.
