

ATS COI109: Counterattack On The Vistula – ATS Conversion 11/08/2009



Near Wola Chodkowska, Poland, 6 August, 1944: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Squad Leader. Ownership of Advanced Tobruk and at least one of Panther Line, Kursk or Stalingrad are necessary for play as are SL boards 4 and 5. Elements of the 220th Rifle Reg, 79th Div. Setup first anywhere on boards 4 or 5 east of row N inclusive.

VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Germans win by being the last side to occupy building 4P6 and both bridge hexes 5Y8 and 5Z9 without suffering 32 casualty victory points. The Russians win by avoiding the German Victory Conditions.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

- Spotting conditions are average.
- Russian Tanks may only use ½ of their MPs during their turn of entry.
- Foxholes may not be placed in a Ravine Hex.
- The woods in hexes 5W9, 5X8 and 5Z8 are considered open ground, Overlay 109
- Building 4P6 is considered a masonry building.
- Russian ATRs may not immobilize a King Tiger PzVIB.
- The required Markers, Data Cards and Overlay are available at ATS On The Table website.
- The Russian Panzerfausts are captured German weapons.
- The Anti Tank Magnetic Mines, ATMs, provide a +2 to a units melee value vs Vehicles.
