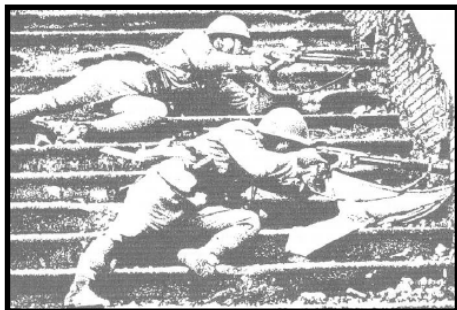


ATS DASL G: INTIMATE WAR – ATS Conversion 09/26/2009



MANILA, THE PHILLIPPINES, 12 FEBRUARY 1945: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Advanced Squad Leader (ASL). Ownership of the DASL Module Streets of Fire is necessary for play as are the ATS games Sempet Fi! and Blood & Iron. Please refer to DASL Scenario A5 for the historical background to this scenario as well as its aftermath.

VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Americans win if the control at least 3 locations on each level of building aK2 at game end.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

1. Spotting conditions are average.
2. Prior to initial setup, the Japanese and the American player each place four rubble markers in any appropriate building hex, none may be placed in building aK2. Alternate placement of these counters, one at a time, starting with the Japanese player.
4. The Japanese may designate any three locations of building aK2 as **Fortified** (Provides additional +1/L to the normal terrain modifier and Friendly units cannot enter a Fortified location that is already occupied by non B/S Enemy units, even by Infiltration or via Sewer Infiltration).
5. For the M1A1 and M2A1 artillery pieces use the markers available at the ATS on The Table website.

BALANCE

- ☆ Extend game length to 8 turns.
- Decrease game length to 6 turns.
