

ATS FKAC101 Throwing Down the Gauntlet – ATS Conversion 05/01/2008



Varaville, France, 6 June 1944: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Advanced Squad Leader. Ownership of Arnhem Defiant Stand or Scottish Corridor are necessary for play as are ASL boards 17 & 33. Please refer to scenario FKAC101 for the historical background to this scenario as well as its aftermath.

VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Canadians win at game end if they have amassed at least 39 Casualty Victory points. In addition, they Canadians receive 3 VPs if they control the bunker and 1 VP per building hex they control within the German setup area.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

1. Spotting conditions are Night.
2. The 33GG5-33Y10-17Y1-17GG5 road is a Creek with the road artwork serving as the Creek artwork. 17GG6 and 33GG6 are open ground. The Creek is deep.
3. All buildings are single story, +0 level only and +10 LOS obstacles.
4. The Canadians have 3 Gammon Bombs.
5. The Germans have 4 AP Mine Factors.
