


# ATS FKAC101 Throwing Down the Gauntlet - ATS Conversion 05/01/2008



**Varaville, France, 6 June 1944:** This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Advanced Squad Leader. Ownership of Arnhem Defiant Stand or Scottish Corridor are necessary for play as are ASL boards 17 & 33. ## VICTORY CONDITIONS


The Canadians win at game end if they have amassed at least 39 Casualty Victory points. In addition, they Canadians receive 3 VPs if they control the bunker and 1 VP per building hex they control within the German setup area.
