

ATS GI 300 Trial By Combat – ATS Conversion 01/13/2008



Elsdorf, Germany, 27 February, 1945: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Squad Leader. Ownership of Advanced Tobruk and Dark December are necessary for play as are SL boards 4 and 8. VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Americans win at game end if they control at least 6 buildings on board 8 east of the river on/between hexrows B-O.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

- Spotting conditions are Hazy.
- All buildings on Board 8 are Masonry. Place overlays as follows W5 on 4H8/G8, W4 on 4K5/K6, W3 on 4L6/M7. All overlay hexsides separating 2 woods hexes should be considered contiguous woods hexes, i.e. no LOS along them, movement across is at the woods MP rate.
- The American M26 morale is 8.
- Required Data Cards, Markers and overlays are available at the ATS On The Table Website.
- The American FO has access to a 80+mm mortar.

BALANCE

- ✚ In the German order of battle exchange an LMG MG34 for an MMG MG42 and add one LAT Panzerschreck.
- ☆ Add one M4A3(L) to the American order of battle.
