VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Americans win at game end by Controlling the following buildings: P5, G9, P8, L9, G2, P1 and K6.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

- Spotting conditions are optimal. All ITR BW rules are in effect.
- Place overlay RC-1 on board 51. Place a Debris overlay on H7. Place rubble markers on H2, H6 and Z4.
- The Germans may designate ≤ 8 building locations as **Fortified**.
- The Germans may use Sewer movement.
- The American 238 crews given in the OB must possess the FTs and SCs at start.
- The American FO may access 1x 81mm Mortar OBA (HE).
