

ATS J58 No. 8 Platoon Overrun – ATS Conversion 11/13/2009



Arnhem, Holland, 18 September 1944: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Advanced Squad Leader (ASL). VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Germans win at game end if they have amassed at least 20 VPs, provided they have amassed more VPs than the British. The Germans receive one VP for each masonry building within the British setup area that they control at game end. Buildings 17, 18, U16 and 20+21, are each worth 2 VP. (all locations of 20 & 21 in these buildings have to be controlled to count for the 2 VPs, i.e. treat as one building).

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

1. Spotting conditions are average.
2. The British have one battery of 80mm (HE Only) OBA with low ammunition. The British FO may use hidden setup.
3. The Germans receive one battery of 105mm (HE and Smoke) OBA directed by a FO at level +20 in any hex on the east edge of the playing area, secretly recorded prior to the British setup.
4. The Germans have one elite tank commander.
5. The British HAT 6 pdr has a 3 Rate of Fire.

Only hexes numbered at least 11 or greater and on/between hexrows U – II are playable.
