

ATS KP5 Marechal's Mill – ATS Conversion 11/03/2009



East of La Gleize, Belgium, 20 December, 1944: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from ASL Kampfgruppe Peiper II. Ownership of Advanced Tobruk, Darkest December and Kampfgruppe Peiper II are necessary for play. Please refer to scenario KP5 for the historical background to this scenario as well as its aftermath.

Blocking force of KG Peiper. Set up first, west of the A44-P52 creek and within 3 hexes of I46; no vehicle may be set up in a building. See SSR 3 & SSR 4.

VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Germans win immediately when they have amassed at least 10 victory points. Otherwise, the Americans win at game end if they have amassed at least 12 victory points and/or they control building(s) H45/I46.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

1. Spotting conditions are Fog.
2. The German has one elite tank commander.
3. Before the German player sets up, but before he assigns his Elite tank commander, he secretly makes a d6 roll for each vehicle. On a roll ≥ 5 , that vehicle is marked Bailed Out. Only two vehicles may be marked Bailed out, stop rolling after a 2nd vehicle becomes abandoned or once all vehicles have been rolled for.
4. Each German AFV must be set up on/adjacent to a road hex and must have hex C46 in its VCA / TCA.
5. No German AFV/APC may expend a movement point until a US unit is spotted.
6. See KP special rules in the BW.
