
VICTORY CONDITIONS

To win the Germans must amass 80 Victory points. VPs are earned normally by causing casualties and by exiting units off the north edge. For every 2 casualty Victory points inflicted on the Germans by the British, add 1 to the German required total.

SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

1. Spotting conditions are Optimal.
2. British Mk VIBs must be set up Dug In. Mark each unit with a Hull defilade marker wherever it sets up. It is HD for all aspects.
3. The British may use Hidden set up for up to 3 squads along with any leader or weapon that sets up with them.
4. The British FOs may access one 76mm OBA, HE only, with one Registration hex. Either FO may call in this battery but only one CFF/FFE is available to be placed per turn.
5. The German FO may access on 105mm OBA, HE only, with High Ammo supply.
