Cambes, France, 08 July 1944: This scenario is a conversion to the Advanced Tobruk System (ATS) from Advanced Squad Leader. Ownership of Scottish Corridor, and Berlin – Red Victory is necessary for play as is ASL NQNG-4. VICTORY CONDITIONS

The British win at game end by earning more VP than the Germans. VP are earned as normal + Exit VP of units exited off the south edge + 1 VP for control of each building/rubble hex.


SPECIAL SCENARIO RULES

- Spotting Conditions are Average. All crops are plowed (MP cost as per crop, but LOS of open ground), and all board 42 hill hexes are ground level orchards. All roads are paved.
- All minefields are setup on board 43 on/south of hexrow AA. The Germans receive a number of Dummy Minefields equal to one DR divided by three (fractions rounded up). All Dummy Minefield counters must be setup next to at least one other 'real' minefield.
- Prior to set up, the Germans shall make a rubble DR for each building on board. A DR ≥ 7 rubbles a wooden building and ≥ 8 rubbles a stone building.
- All German SS infantry are Die Hard SS. They suffer -2 on overruns and friendly surrendered or broken enemy units in MSR have no effect. All crews are SS 2|3|9, including vehicles.

BALANCE

- Change the M|MG to a H|MG.
- Give Courage to one leader in the British OoB.
