VICTORY CONDITIONS: The Allies win at game end if there are no unbroken Italian Squad ≤ 7 hexes from S6.

SCENARIO SPECIAL RULES:

1. Allied Leaders incur the following penalties when attempting to rally or direct units of a different nationality:

- NCO,s don't provide +1 morale / 1R / -1 HPT DRM.
- Officers only provide +1 morale / 1R / -1 HPT DRM.

Add a Fiat-Rev 35 MMG to the Italian OB.



The Turn 4 reinforcements enter on Turn 3.
