VICTORY CONDITIONS

The Germans win at game end by exiting ≥ 25 VP off the north edge provided the Americans have amassed ≤ 32 VP.

1. Spotting conditions are Optimal. All Hedges are Bocage.
2. German AFV morale is 1 less than on the Data cards.
